


Press Release - Invitation April

After introducing my graduate degree thesis, regarding “Occupational Gender Segregation”, I entered partnerships, with various stakeholders, thus nowadays I train women, to become professional drivers, thus through my NGO “Miss Taxi Ghana”, we’ve rolled out “She Drives The City Project” to further develop the Ghanaian transport sector.
